REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- Complete a separate registration form for each child—photocopy additional forms as needed.
- Complete all portions of the **Camp Registration Form**, including **SIGNATURE**. Only completed forms will be processed.
- Register for the program appropriate to the age of your camper. Children must have their 5th, 7th, or 9th birthday by the first day of registered camp. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Proof of age may be required.
- Register your child only once for the same camp. Duplications cannot be processed.
- You may mail, fax, or deliver your registration form to Cape Fear Museum. Only registrations with full payment will be processed.
- Registrations taken on a “first come, first served” basis. Once registration forms have been processed, a confirmation letter will be mailed.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES

The deadline for registration is 5PM on the Wednesday before the camp begins, providing that space is available. Early registration is encouraged. The Museum reserves the right to limit class size.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations made 14 days before the camp begins will receive a refund equal to the cost of the camp, minus a \$10 service fee per camper per program. Cancellations made later will receive no refund. In case of insufficient registration, the Museum may cancel a program two weeks before the start of a session. In this instance, participants will receive a full refund.

CAMP FEES

Payment of total fees must be submitted with registration form. Museum membership must be valid at time of registration to receive member rate.

CAMPER EXPECTATIONS

A camper with behavioral problems may be requested to leave camp. In such a case, camp fees will be forfeited and no refund will be given.

FOOD REQUIREMENTS

All campers are required to bring a nutritious snack each day of camp. The Museum will provide only water.

PICK-UP PASSES

Please make sure that you receive pick-up passes for the week(s) your child(ren) are registered for camp. A parent, guardian, or adult designee must show the pickup pass to the educator each day when picking up a child.

LATE FEES

Campers must be picked up promptly at **12NOON** on each day of camp. A late fee of \$5 will be assessed for every 15 minutes (or portion thereof) the camper remains in Museum care beyond the regular hours of camp.
