CAPE FEAR STORIES

This exhibition explores major historical themes focusing on people and events that shaped local, regional, and state history, from prehistory through the 20th century.

MICHAEL JORDAN DISCOVERY GALLERY

This exhibition presents the Lower Cape Fear's main ecosystems and highlights their features, flora, and fauna.

GIANT GROUND SLOTH

A 15-foot-tall reproduction skeleton of the mammal whose fossilized remains were found locally.

WE LEARN NOT FOR SCHOOL, BUT FOR LIFE

The photo-documentary exhibit celebrates the history of Williston, a local African-American high school.

MARITIME PAVILION

The outdoor gallery features watercraft people have used to travel around the region. A Simmons Sea-Skiff is also on display in the Museum lobby.
