JOURNEY BACK IN TIME TO EXPLORE DINOSAURS AND MORE!

Examine fossils and “trace fossils”, compare your body size to a *Tyrannosaurus*, move like a giant ground sloth, and role-play the job of a paleontologist. In this hands-on educational adventure, students work to measure, sort, compare, and contrast dinosaurs and other prehistoric creatures.

PROGRAM ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

DINOSAUR LIFE & TIMES

Figure out what a dinosaur is and isn't, and create a “living timeline” to discover that not all dinosaurs lived at the same time.

DINO-MEASUREMENTS

Work in groups to measure dinosaurs and their footprints. See how humans “measure up” to some of the most recognizable dinosaurs.

DINOSAUR DISCOVERY

Explore the job of a paleontologist and reassemble a dinosaur skeleton.

CAPE FEAR DINOSAURS & MORE

Discover which dinosaurs and other prehistoric creatures once roamed our region.

EXTINCT!?

Identify elements that living creatures need for survival, then relate those needs to how dinosaurs went extinct.

PREHISTORIC SLOTH

Not all prehistoric creatures were dinosaurs! Examine the bones and teeth of a giant ground sloth found locally and hear fascinating facts, including the strange way they moved.
