MYTHS AND LEGENDS

Explore constellation myths and legends from ancient Greek, Native American, Chinese and African cultures.

Identify, compare and contrast features of star pictures across cultures.

MARVELOUS MOON

Listen to a story about the moon from indigenous peoples of northern Mexico and observe how the moon appears to change shape from night to night.

CONSTELLATION CREATION

Create a constellation to take home and imagine your own star story.
